Year 11 Pathways at Tranby College

Helping you navigate the pathways to make your dreams possible.



Four Journeys. Many Destinations.

UniDirect

Direct entry to university by achieving required ATAR grades (or equivalent).

TAFEReady

Vocational Education and Training (VET), this pathway prepares you for admission into TAFE.

UniReady

Direct entry to selected Curtin University courses by completing subject units.

TrainingDirect

Delivered in partnership with a Registered Training Organisation or TAFE, this pathway is ideal for those interested in trades or apprentices.

UniDirect

University entrance by ATAR requires students to:

- Study a minimum for four ATAR courses in Years 11 and 12.
- Achieve their WACE.
- Satisfy a competence in English requirement.

Depends on the requirements for each university.

- Combined scaled mark of at least 50% OR
- C-Grade in Year 12 English-ATAR or Literature-ATAR.
- Achieve the required Australian Tertiary Admission Rank (ATAR).
- Satisfy any prerequisites or special requirements.
- Prerequisites are a scaled mark of 50% in specific courses.



TAFEReady

- This pathway prepares you for a TAFE qualification, work-based training or employment.
- Students choose a combination of courses and certificates.
- Typically students choose General-level courses but should choose a mix of courses that are interesting and appropriately challenging for the them.

UniReady

- UniReady is designed for students who want to go to university but do not want to do a full ATAR program.
- Students study four units: two in Year 11 and two in Year 12.
- They will need to select a combination of ATAR and General courses to contribute to a WACE.


Note:

We recommend a maximum of three ATAR courses.

However, a WACE (including achieving competence in OLNA) is not required for entry to Curtin University via Tranby's UniReady pathway.

TrainingDirect

VET (Vocational Education and Training)

- Nationally recognised qualifications in various areas.
 - Certificates I, II, III or IV.
- Contributes to a student's WACE.
- Can provide direct access to higher VET certificates or university entrance.
- Delivered by Tranby College or external registered training organisations.



Pathway Choices

All of Tranby's pathways are equally important and rigorous.

Tranby, unlike many schools, allows a combination of courses, programs and certificates to best achieve the individual student's goals.

Pay careful attention to the minimum standards for the courses and pathways, that is require.





Pathway Choices


University and TAFE entry is competitive, and both are equally important.

Apprenticeships and Traineeships are competitive and important.

Students need to strive to do their best in whichever pathway they choose.

An A-grade and B-grade open more doors than a C-grade.

Which Pathway for Me?



If You Wish to go to University:

- If you are achieving a minimum of B-grades in your Year 10 subjects, including English: UniDirect
- If you are achieving above 50% in your Year 10 subjects and achieving a C-grade in English:

 UniReady



If You Wish to go to TAFE or Training:

Trade or Apprenticeship-Based: TrainingDirect

- Consider a VETDSS; and
- Choose General Courses with the highest level English or Mathematics that you can achieve a high grade in.

Vocational-Based Course: TAFEReady

- Choose General Courses; and
- Choose a Certificate if it is related to your interests or abilities.

- Choose one course from each line, plus a back-up from lines 2, 3, 4 and 6.
 - You will study 6 courses or certificates plus a study line.
- Complete your course selection using the online portal and web code provided before 3.15pm on 7th August 2024.
